

CLUB RULES - PARENTS RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR CHILDREN

Parents/Guardians are responsible for their own children at all times, and **must be at the park**.

In emergency situations, if a parent cannot be present, they must coordinate with a secondary responsible adult to have direct supervision over their players. In the case of U6 players, make sure your emergency supervisor is prepared to stay by the U6 field. Those in babysitting **MUST** have their parent on the field.

The parent must inform the coach, Team Mom, and Field Coordinator about emergency arrangements.

The coach **MAY NOT BE** considered the “secondary responsible adult”.

The child may be asked to sit out if the parent cannot be located on the field.

Child Pick-up after practice

- Pick up children from youngest to oldest
- Older children are permitted to pick up younger siblings
- For Babysitting children, U6 Players, and U8 Players, please “check out” with the Babysitter or Team Mom

U6 Players

We have special consideration for our youngest players

- U6 parents need to be in close proximity to the U6 field unless they are coaching or an on duty-team mom/babysitter.
- Practice is only 1 ½ hours.
- Must have family member or pre-arranged adult pick them up at the end of practice.
- U6 players whose parents are coaches may be taken by the team moms to the babysitting area at the end of practice. Please arrange this with the Team Moms prior to practice and make sure your field coordinator is aware of the need for extra babysitting during this last half-hour. Team moms may need to provide this extra care.
- U6 rosters should include a list of where the parents are serving and which children go to babysitting after practice.

U8 Players

Must have family member or pre-arranged adult pick them up at the end of practice
Team Moms will wait with the child
